CD Committee - Jenny Fortman made motion to allocated \$600 for flyer printing and distribution, Joy Smallfield 2nd, motion passed

McDonalds was present to discuss future developments at the current McDonalds site, Councilmember Frey was present at discussion. Concerns raised included previous commitments that went unfulfilled as well as concerns about what effects the new construction would have on the neighborhood. Sheridan had already written and passed a letter to the city citing concerns with the expansion.

Metro Blooms, Jenny Fortman made motion to allocate \$600 for advertising for raingarden program, David Hildebrandt 2nd, motion passed

Nancy Pryzmus gave a presentation about a program reading to the Somali community in the neighborhood. Typical attendance has grown to 50-60 children, Sheridan asked to help support the program both through promoting the program and/or allocating an appropriation to defray the cost of books, which can cost up to \$70/week. Decision was laid over until the next meeting.

Discussion was had about the proposed liquor store at the corner of Broadway and Marshall. Boardmembers expressed concern about the project. Motion was made to take a position of opposition, there was no second, motion was laid on the table.
