INTRODUCTIONS:

Board Members Present: Maryjo, Joy, Carin, Jordan, Mike

TREASURE REPORT:

Seaan was out and there is not a treasure's report this month.

OPEN MIC:

TERESA LENO - NE FARMER'S MARKET:

Looking for support for the farmer's market again. We did \$1200 last year.

NAILAH'S PROJECT/WORK UPDATES:

Annual Report - Due March 15th - Nailah will send out to Board and we will need to vote on it before next meeting.

Website - Square Space is a little more expensive, but is more user friendly. It is \$216/year for Square Space. Mike makes a motion to approve \$500 for website updates/improvements for the year. Maryjo seconds motion. Passes unanimously.

ROADMAP 2020 - CARIN PETERSON:

Carin provided information on the three work groups of the 2020 program and also the pamphlet that the City produced as a summary.

Discussion about concerns that it seems the City is trying to get rid of neighborhood groups.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS/MOTIONS:

Modification to NRP Phase II (Revolving Loan Fund) strategy expanding the language to include grants, as well as loans. This would allow for greater flexibility in how to implement the strategy and could possibly support the Homeowner Navigation Program or other options in the future. Board is giving notice that they will vote on this change to the language at the March 2019 SNO meeting.

Raingardens - SNO cost for five gardens is \$4,525 or \$1,875 for three gardens. SNO committed to five rain gardens.

Clean Sweep - April 13th or April 20th are available - will wait to hear back from Hilari at Dangerous Man what date works for them.

Staff Wages - Board will discuss this further at our next board meeting, March 2019.

Fix & Paint - funds will need to be moved for this strategy. Board is giving notice that further discussion and voting will happen at March 2019 meeting.

NE Arts District Banners - Total for SNO Arts District sign is \$8,100. Chamber is working a matching grant. Board is considering moving funds to support this and will discuss further at the next board meeting.

GAF COMPANY/LOWRY BRIDGE CANCER & ASTHMA STUDY:

Jordan makes a motion to draft a letter of SNO support of the study/end of pollution to the four legislatures listed on flyer and also Steve Fletcher. Mike seconds motion. Passes unanimously.

BROADWAY TASK FORCE:

County is going to do a mill and overlay this coming Summer - but the county is now more interested in a traffic study and low hanging improvements while doing the mill and overlay.
